Donor Milk Distribution Associate

Position Summary:

Reporting to the Director of Operations, the Donor Milk Distribution Associate performs duties pertaining to the distribution of pasteurized donor human milk in conjunction with the other members of the Distribution team.

Core Responsibilities:

- Answering and triaging calls for the Distribution Department
- Monitoring order requests
- Batch selection for fulfilling hospital or outpatient orders
- Filling and packing hospital and outpatient donor milk orders
- Coordinating courier pickups and shipping
- Managing inventory
- Intake of new outpatients and new hospital accounts
- Communication with hospitals, dispensaries, and outpatient families
- Co-ordination of depot and dispensary shipments
- Ordering boxes and shipping supplies
- Monitoring of freezer/refrigerator alerts
- Other duties, as assigned.

Secondary Duties

All staff members are cross trained in another milk bank department (screening, lab, or administration) to assist as needed. Determination of additional team will be based on the employee's experience, background, and education. Limited travel opportunities to education and outreach activities (not required).

Education:

Minimum of Associate degree preferred. Other combinations of education and experience will be considered.

- Experience in a lab, hospital, medical practice, or food production helpful
- Excellent organizational skills with exceptional attention to detail.
